Purpose

The majority of Jamaicans are descendants of African slaves who were captured and brought to the island in the 17th and 18th century.

The purpose of “Reggae For A Cause” is to pave the way for poor descendants of slaves to make a journey back to Africa to learn more about their roots, the culture of their ancestors and see the places where they were imprisoned before they were crammed together on the slave ships and brought across the Atlantic Ocean to America and the Caribbean. It will help them to define who they are and reinforce their identity and dignity.

Procedure

The “C.o.J.C.& D.” will set up an office in Jamaica to deal with the necessary formalities. Road managers will bring the group for the journey together. Those who are living below poverty level will be in first line.

For the beginning the first destination will be Ghana to visit places like “Cape Coast Castle”, “Elmina

Castle” and “Fort Christiansborg” also named as “Door of No Return”.

The vacationers will receive a warm reception and a “Restoration Center” will be set up for accommodation and sustenance. Each vacationer will stay for two or three weeks.
